PARKING:

SENIOR SWIMMING SPORTS

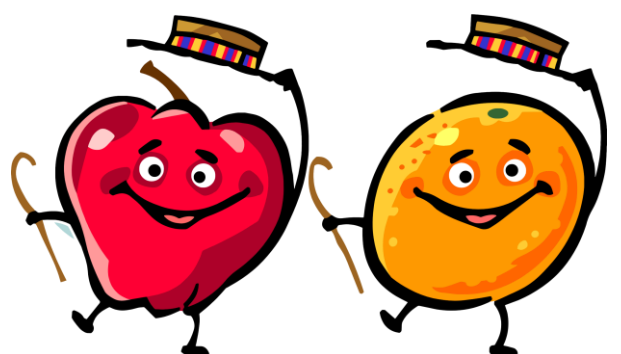
