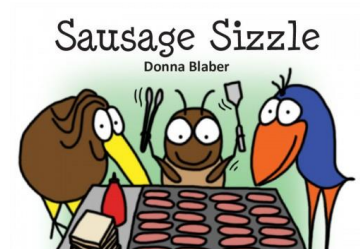
She can also offer advice on health and link you with certain community services.

## A FREE COURSE ABLE TO BE UNDERTAKEN AT HOME

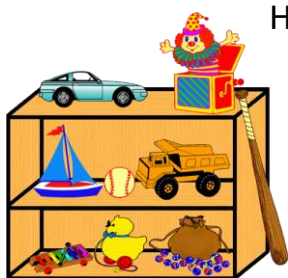
### Programme overview:
