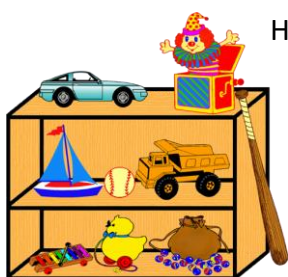
Does anyone have any electronic or electrical goods that are no longer in use? Our Junior children would love to tinker and pull them apart to see what makes them tick!
