### Rheumatic Fever Prevention Programme

#### School Holidays



**STREP A can lead to Rheumatic Fever Heart Disease if left untreated. A throat swab is very important to identify Strep A.**

Should your child have a sore throat please take your child to see your family doctor, or to White Cross, or to the three Pharmacies listed below. These services are all **FREE** (for all Northland children under 13 years of age.)

A throat swab is the only way to identify “Strep A bacteria”. Treating “Strep A” ***immediately***, once it has been identified, to prevent further risk of Rheumatic fever heart disease.

A **FREE** course of antibiotic treatment, ***must be taken every day for the full 10 days*** to prevent further risk of the bug developing into Rheumatic Fever.
