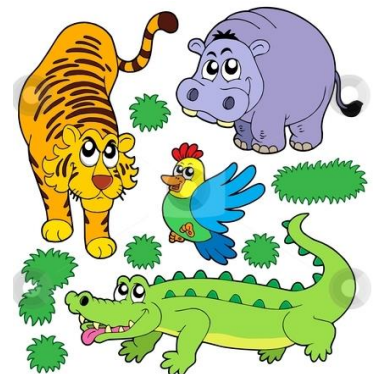

ZOO TRIPS

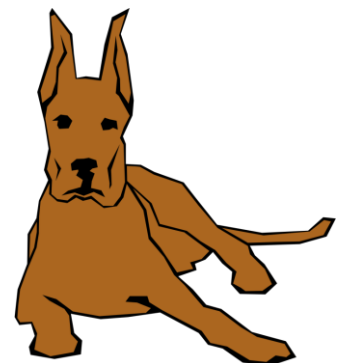
