Room 14 are well underway planting the Rongoa Garden in the Eco Park.

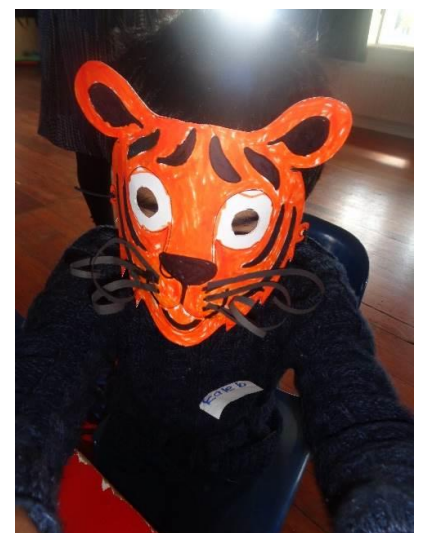
The class would like to acknowledge the support provided by **Forest Floor Nurseries in Maungatapere.**
