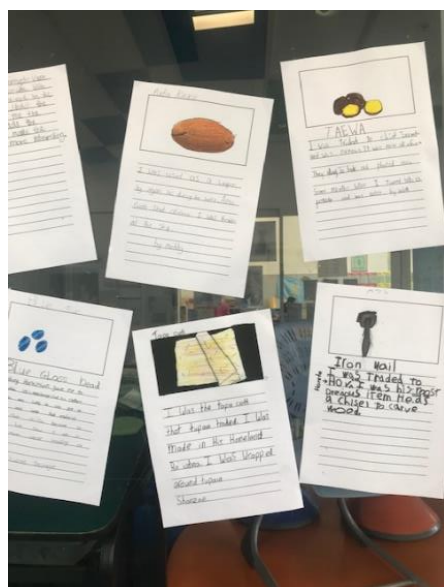
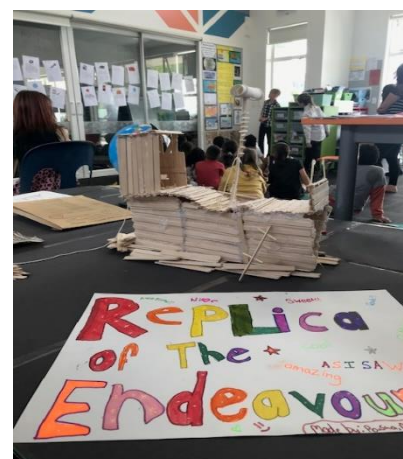


The museum was interesting. I was surprised that they were all dead. I saw the flag, it was red and blue. The rock was a weapon. Wow Room 16 that was awesome!

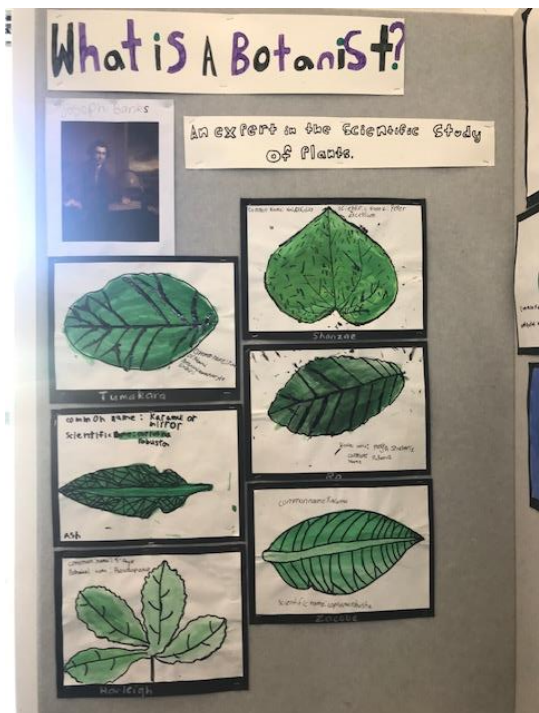


I can't believe the biscuit is iron and I can't also believe the paint brush hair is made out of camel hair. I have learned a lot of things from you Room 16.
