ICE BLOCK FUNDRAISER

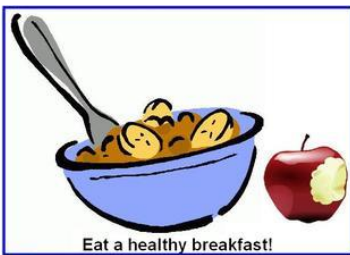

SUPER SUMMER SALADS

KUMARA SALAD

Serves 6

- 3 kumara – cut into cubes
- 2 Tbsp. oil
- 1 capsicum - chopped
- ½ red onion – chopped
- large handful of salad greens e.g. spinach
- optional: 70g Feta – cut into cubes
- 2 tsp. honey
- juice of 1 lemon

Place kumara in a roasting dish, drizzle with oil and bake at 180° for 20 minutes. Remove from oven to cool then toss with the vegetables.

In a bowl whisk together honey and lemon juice then drizzle over the salad.

Please ensure that the school has your current address if you have moved since the last BOT Election.

Additional nomination forms, if required, are available from the school office. Anyone can be nominated to be a trustee - a candidate does not need to be a parent of a student enrolled at the school. If you are on the school roll and eligible to vote then you can nominate yourself; however, if you are not on the voting roll, you must be nominated by a parent who is.

Please enclose with your nomination a candidate statement (up to 400 words) to be sent with voting papers. Nomination Forms and Candidate Statements must be received by noon Friday 17 November 2017.
